Welcome and Introductions

1. April Minutes – Crane Cesario

2. CT HMIS Vice Chair Position – Crane Cesario

- Noel Kammermann is moving on

3. CaseWorthy & Data Standard Upgrade(s) – Nutmeg

- Last meeting a timeline was laid out for three various upgrades: upgrading the database server, then upgrade to CW version 7, then the HUD data standard upgrade in early October
- CaseWorthy version 7 will not require an update to the user interface, and will not require any trainings for the end users.
- Need to modify the timeframe because of CaseWorthy issues.
- Best estimate first upgrade in early July for the server upgrade, and then upgrade CaseWorthy in August.

4. CT HMIS Reports Webinar – Nutmeg

- Recording will be posted to the cthmis.com website when it is complete
- Webinar can be of use to anyone, regardless of project type.
- CaseWorthy Analytics currently released and available to all users in the platform.

5. Sage Platform & APR Uploads – Nutmeg

- Worked with projects on their SAGE uploads
- Grant information has been known to be incorrect in some projects (grant numbers, operating years, etc) – this information is uploaded outside of CT HMIS and should be double checked.
- Issues that have been identified with the CSV extract have all been resolved.
- Working to resolve issues with dates of entry assessments not matching their enrollment dates, and the same for exit dates and exit assessments being on different days.



- Start date and birth date cannot be the same in the system, even with newborns.
- SAGE does have a test upload encourage projects to test upload their data. The test is available on the front page of SAGE, and will not impact the actual submission.
- Timeliness table: there is no scoring currently encourage communities to evaluate how long it is taking people to actually enter the data.

6. Annual Assessment Reminder – Nutmeg

- Reminder that annual assessments are necessary for the correct population of the APR.
- Reminder that three is a three business day turnaround for helpdesk tickets and to please run reports in advance of their due dates.
