

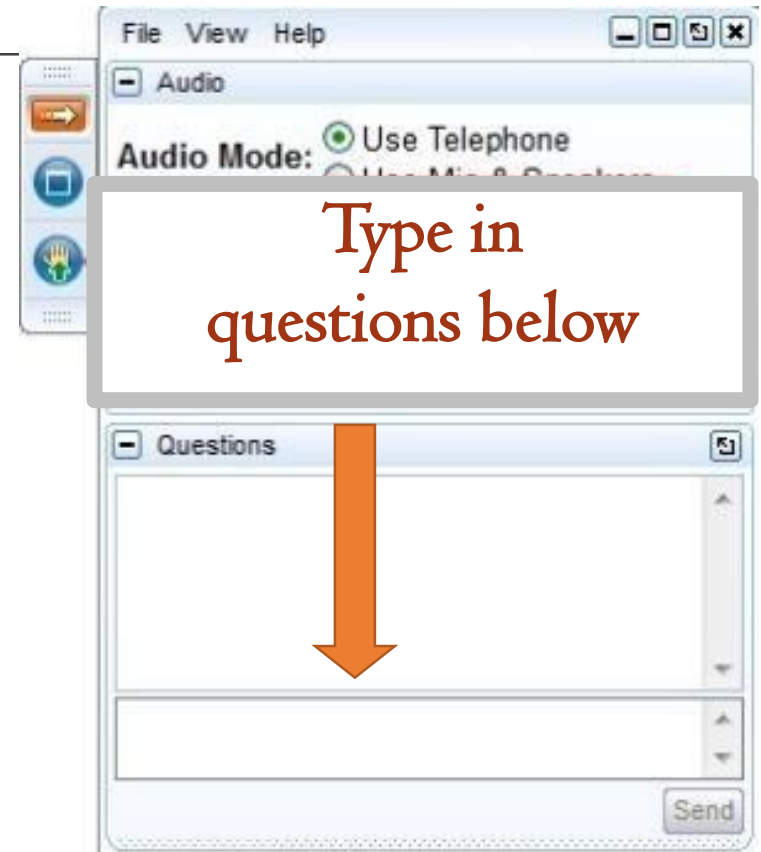

Point-in-Time Count and HIC

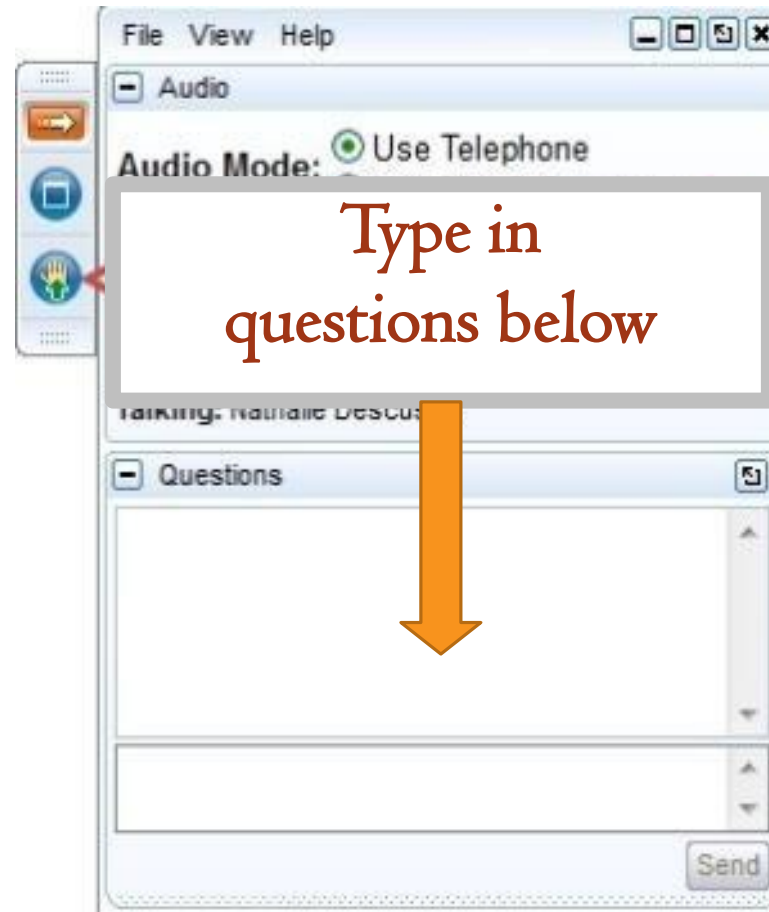
- The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is a count of sheltered and unsheltered people experiencing homelessness on a single night in January.
- HUD requires that Continuums of Care conduct an **annual count of people experiencing homelessness who are sheltered in emergency shelter, transitional housing, and Safe Havens on a single night.**
- The Housing Inventory Count (HIC) is a point-in-time inventory of provider programs within a Continuum of Care that provide beds and units dedicated to serve people experiencing homelessness (and, for permanent housing projects, where homeless at entry, per the [HUD homeless definition](#)), categorized by five Program Types: Emergency Shelter; Transitional Housing; Rapid Re-housing; Safe Haven; and Permanent Supportive Housing.
- Data for the PIT count and HIC are submitted to HUD via the online data submission [Homelessness Data Exchange \(HDX\)](#).

People Count

- All Homeless Service Providers enter information into the online PIT Database
- Confirm the project capacity (bed count), address, and funding sources by Wednesday, November 18th **[DONE]**
- ▪ You will also be required to **enter the total people** in that project **ON THE NIGHT OF PIT (Tuesday, January 26th)**
