## Vaccine Access Update 2-26-21

This week, the Governor announced changes to the state's vaccination plan.

On March 1<sup>st</sup>, CT will move primarily to age-based prioritization according to this schedule: https://portal.ct.gov/Coronavirus/COVID-19-Vaccination---Phases

To summarize relevant changes for our provider members:

- Residents and staff of congregate settings will continue to be prioritized on an ongoing basis.
- Educators and childcare providers will be prioritized alongside ages 55+, starting March 1.
- There is no longer a priority for other frontline essential workers.

Since late October, CCEH has forwarded communications from CT DPH indicating your frontline, essential staff were considered part of Phase 1b. Though many of your staff *have* been prioritized under the congregate settings plan, I want to acknowledge this is a real change that may impact some of your staff.

## **Storing Client Vaccine Records**

Please watch for announcements from Nutmeg and CCEH when those go live in CT's HMIS.

Meanwhile, CCEH encourages providers to obtain client permission to collect and store copies of COVID vaccination records, which will facilitate updating these fields as they become available in HMIS. You may use the HMIS files and documents section of the client record for this purpose.
