Chronic Homelessness - DedicatedPlus Verified

What are the changes?

A new Chronic Homeless status of “DedicatedPLUS Verified” has been added to the Client Status on By Name List (BNL) form to assist in identifying compatible clients.

What is a DedicatedPLUS project?

A DedicatedPLUS project is a permanent supportive housing project where 100% of the beds are dedicated to serve individuals, households with children, **and** unaccompanied youth that meet specific criteria.

Which users are impacted?

Users of the By Name List and “Client Status on By Name List (BNL)” menu item under the “Coordinated Access – Network” who are taking part in a DedicatedPLUS project

The change allows quick identification of clients who have been labeled as DedicatedPLUS .

This change is expected to be rolled out on Wednesday, December 30, 2020
