COVID-19 Vaccination Tracking

March 18, 2021

What are the changes?

A new feature has been added to COVID-19 vaccination status for your clients. The following information can now be tracked within CaseWorthy:

- Vaccination Status
- First and Second Dose Scheduling
- COVID-19 Vaccine Type Used
- Immunization Information System (IIS) Recipient ID*

*NOTE: The 'COVID-19 Immunization Information System (IIS) Recipient ID' appears on the COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card given to each patient. It is currently an optional field as not every patient has this number recorded by the provider.

The new form is located under:

Case Management tab > Left Menu > COVID-19 > COVID 19 Vaccinations (CURRENT CLIENT).

A simple report has been added to view the vaccination data: Case Management tab > Left Menu > COVID-19 > COVID 19 Vaccinations Report.

Reminder: Collecting this information does not make a program subject to the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

Which users are impacted?

The following roles have access to COVID-19 vaccination data:

- Coordinated Access Network
- DMHAS/DDAP
- DOH AIDS / HOPWA
- DOH Emergency Solutions (ESG)
- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- PATH Outreach
- Runaway Homeless Youth
- Services Only
- Supportive Housing Works
- Supportive Services (SSVF)
- Transitional Living (TLP)



How does this help?

Vaccination data can be used to:

- Determine how many people experiencing homelessness are vaccinated or scheduled to be vaccinated.
- Remind people who may need their second dose of vaccine.
- Mitigate ongoing COVID-19 outbreaks in congregate shelters.




