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What are the changes?

The CT HMIS CaseWorthy database is being updated to support the FY 2022 HMIS Data Standards as well as introduce some interface updates to the CaseWorthy platform.

Which users are impacted?

The FY 2022 CaseWorthy Data Standards and Interface updates will impact all users of the system. There are also program specific changes. It is recommended that you review this document completely for information on which elements may be applicable to your programs.

How does this help?

These changes bring us in compliance with HUD's latest required data standards for data collection, reporting and system setup.




User Interface Changes

The CaseWorthy software user interface has been updated with small visual changes. The top menu now features the CaseWorthy logo and the top navigation items are now text instead of icons.



Clients with multiple genders selected are now shown with an icon and "Multiple Gender Identities" as the gender text.











3.05 - Ethnicity




Description of Change








W3 - Medical Assistance






W6 - Prescribed Antiretroviral
