Program Overview

- \$30,000,000 in funding
- Date of application: 6/12/23-11/30/23
- Eligible tenants may receive rental assistance during months they are registered for a federally funded workforce training program
- Tenants may receive 3 months of future rent at a time, with the ability to recertify for 3 additional months at a time









Roles

"Grantees" or Workforce Boards & CBOs

- Refer tenants through the Screening Tool
- Ensure eligible tenant is registered for CareerConnect
- Fill out the original application for each eligible tenant; if a tenant wishes to recertify then staff will also submit the recertification on behalf of the tenant
- Notify landlord of tenant application and next steps

Department of Housing

- Screen applicants to ensure a household has not received \$15,000 or 12 months of rental assistance
- Send list of eligible tenants to the Workforce Boards to start an application
- Oversee the underwriting and payment of approved applications

Office of Workforce Strategy

- Oversee CareerConnect process
- Convene partners as necessary





Eligibility

Tenant

- Income up to 80% AMI
- Tenant has not previously received the maximum 12 months or \$15,000 of UniteCT rental assistance
- Tenant is participating in a federally-funded workforce training program in CT such as CareerConneCT or WIOA, and are registered and assessed for training as of June 5, 2023 up until November 30, 2023, or started training as of June 5, 2023 up until November 30, 2023, and registered in CTHires

Landlord

Must own the home (no subletters)





Required Documents

Tenant

- ID
- 4 weeks of most recent income for each adult in the household
 - Only for tenants who do not live in a Qualified Census Tract (QCT)
- Lease
- Landlord Verification Form (template provided)

Landlord

- ID or business license
- Signed W9
- Lease






